Oct. 10, 2020

Thank you for your prayers and support of our ministry. In August we baptized nine new believers despite new restrictions placed on public meetings. We baptized three more people at the end of September. Although there have been new restrictions because of the corona virus, we have continued to meet in small groups, discipling and leading people to the Lord.

I regret to tell you that my dear husband, Fernando, went to be with the Lord on September 9th. He became ill and had to go to the hospital, where he died after a week of complications from pneumonia and sepsis. We had been married for over fifty two years and served together in Spain for the last thirty-five. As you can imagine, I miss him terribly.

Our national pastor is now leading the work and I will continue to work in the women's ministry as long as the Lord permits. At the moment, I feel a bit lost, but know that God will continue to be my strength. One of Fernando's duties was the prayer letter, therefore I ask for your patience as I work on getting future letters out. I didn't realize that we had not sent one for a few months. I am certain it was because he had been unwell.

I ask for your continued prayers for the ministry and for me personally. I was unable to open his prayer letter files and that is why I have delayed writing to you. I hope to get the hang of attaching pictures like Fernando like to share with you.
